Michigan Audubon Sanctuaries

Michigan Audubon, the state's first conservation organization, was established in 1904. It has worked through the years to study and preserve wild birds and bird habitats. Headquartered in Lansing, Michigan Audubon consists of 42 chapters and over 2000 individual members.

Michigan Audubon's bird sanctuary system protects over 5,000 acres in 19 properties from southern Michigan to the Keweenaw Peninsula. The sanctuaries range in size from less than 20 acres to over 900 acres.

Four of Michigan Audubon's sanctuaries occur within global Important Birds Areas (IBA). The IBA program in Michigan is directed by Bird Life International and the National Audubon Society, in partnership with Michigan Audubon, Detroit Audubon and the Kalamazoo Nature Center.

Maintaining Michigan Audubon sanctuaries promotes awareness, understanding, enjoyment and stewardship of the environment. To learn more about Michigan Audubon's sanctuaries, visit

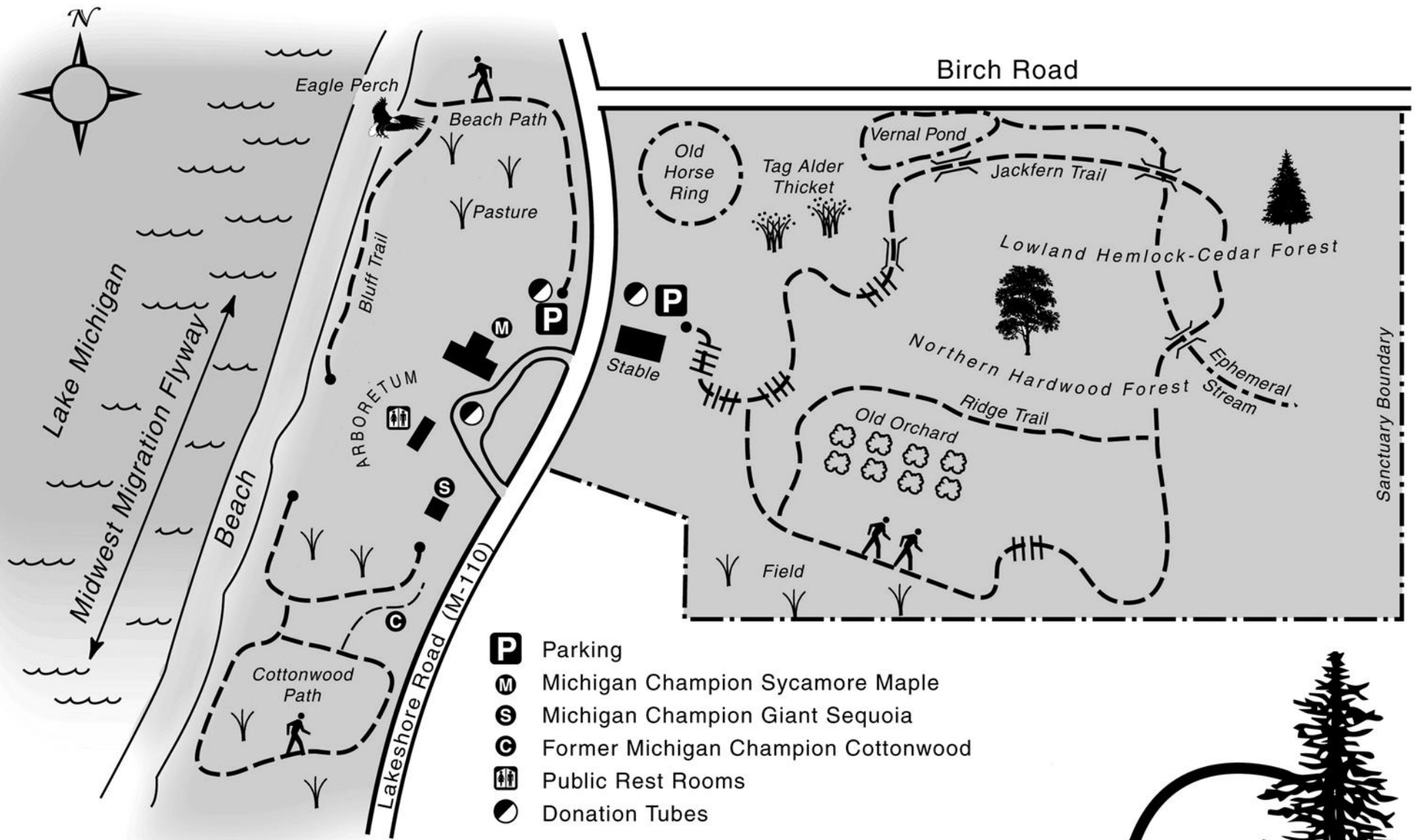
